Education

- UF College of Nursing is a major provider of BSN/RNs in the state. (Peer-reviewed national studies demonstrate that BSN-prepared nurses have positive impact on mortality rate of patients.)
- Innovative education programs to address national shortage of nurses and nursing faculty.
 - BSN to PhD
 - Accelerated BSN for college graduates from other fields
 - Clinical Nurse Leader MSN program
- New Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) for advanced practice roles.
- Cooperative degree with FAMU, FSU, UNF, UWF for UF's PhD program via distance learning.
- Graduates consistently exceed national and state pass rates on the N-CLEX RN licensure exam, averaging pass rates above 96%.

Patient Care/Outreach

- First nursing faculty practice plan in Florida. Currently provides care in over 20 locations and supports 8 faculty positions.
- Nurse-managed health center in Archer, Florida; providing primary, psychiatric – mental health and community health care for underserved populations.
- Innovative Tobacco Cessation Program that includes student education, community outreach, and individual and group support.
- Collaborative agreement with Nursing Education Program at Medical University of Gdansk, Poland with student and faculty exchanges.

Research

- Funded interdisciplinary research programs focused on women's health and health disparities, autism, mental health, aging, and infant development.
- Endowed Chairs to lead research in aging, clinical excellence and cancer care.
- Blue Cross and Blue Shield Center (collaborating with College of Public Health and Health Professions) focusing on patient safety and health policy.
